



2014 Rancho Guejito Vineyard Rosé

We are excited for the second harvest from Rancho Guejito Vineyards block at Rockwood Ranch. This field style blend of Mourvèdre, Counoise and Grenache were planted with dreams of rosé.

Vineyard Notes

The vineyard was established in 2011 23 miles from the Pacific Ocean at an elevation of 428 feet on Visalia sandy loam soils at the mouth of Rockwood Canyon in San Pasqual Valley. The trellising consists of a modified sprawl with 8' X 6' spacing.

Vintage Notes

Harvested early in the morning on August 26th, the clusters went straight into the press. The juice was then blended into a stainless tank before fermentation was allowed to take place without inoculation. After 6 months on lees the wine was racked to bottle without filtration.
